Centopassi

Centopassi is the winemaking soul of Libera Terra cooperatives that cultivate lands in Sicily seized from the mafia.

The vineyards are located in the Alto Belice Corleonese, an overwhelmingly beautiful territory, which is particularly suitable for high quality wine production. Vast and untainted landscapes, high altitudes that exceed 3,000 feet above the sea level, calcareous peaks and predominantly clay-rich soils make this corner of the Mediterranean an ideal place for wine growing and unlike most stereotypes attributed to Sicilian wine.

The wines display the characteristics of each vineyard, soil and grape variety. Here elegance prevails, freshness is everywhere, ensuring wine drinkability thanks to painstaking care for the vineyards and to wine making processes, which emphasize the maximum expression of the fruit.





Rocce di Pietra Longa - Grillo DOC Sicilia 2020

Grape variety: Grillo 100%

Agronomic management: organic farming.

Vineyard: Pietralunga (550 m a.s.l.) - Monreale (PA).

Soil: clay-rich soil, whit coarse rock fragments and outcrops.

Harvest: in boxes, second ten days of August.

Average yield: 4 t/ha.

Vinification: soft crushing and fermentation in steel vats.

Maturation: on its own yeasts in steel vats for 9 months .

Alcohol: 13. 90 %

Total acidity: 6.92 g/l.

pH: 3.09.

Production: 6,000 bottles.

Harvest: in boxes, second half of September.

Average yield: 6 t/ha.

Vinification: soft crushing and fermentation in steel vats.

Maturation: on its own yeasts in steel vats (90%) and clayver (10%) for 9 months.

Alcohol: 13.50 %

Total acidity: 5.91 g/l.

Vinification: destemming, 18-hour maceration and fermentation in tonneaux (Taransaud) both new and used.

Maturation: in new and used tonneaux (Taransaud) for 12 months.

Alcohol: 13.07 %



The Giato project

Giato is the name of the old district that surrounded amazing Greek theatre located on the top of Mount Jato. This place overlooks Jato Valley, Belice upland and the most important core of the Centopassi vineyards.

The peak of Mount Jato is on 850 meters on sea level. This allowed, in the ancient time, to have a highly strategic position and to supervise, from one side, the crossing point to access in Conca (Horn of Plenty) and (old name of Palermo) Phoenician-Punic emporium and, from the other side, the Belice River Valley through which it was possible to reach Selinunte, ancient Greek colony, and the Sicilian South coast. This area was inhabited ever since the beginning of the first millennia before Christ by the ancient populations that settled on the islands as the Elymians-Sican. In this place, since the 300 before Christ, the Greek village of Jaitas has blossomed and lived its most flourishing period.

Giato wines come from some of our best Sicilian grapes. They represent the highest point of the Centopassi blend's excellence project aimed at valorizing traditional and typical vineyards of Western Sicily.
