Centopassi is the winemaking entity of Libera Terra cooperatives that cultivate land confiscated from the mafia in Sicily.

The vineyards are distributed in the Alto Belice Corleonese, an area where nature dominates, with overwhelming beauty, unmistakable horizons, and unforgettable sunsets.

The wines tell the diversity of each vineyard, of the soils that distinguish them, and of the vines that from time to time enhance their characteristics.

The wines display the characteristics of each vineyard, soil and grape variety. Here elegance prevails, freshness is everywhere, ensuring wine drinkability thanks to painstaking care for the vineyards and to wine making processes, which emphasize the maximum expression of the fruit.





Rocce di Pietra Longa - Grillo DOC Sicilia 2021

Grape varieties: Grillo 100%

Agronomic approach: certified organic.

Vineyard: Pietralunga (1,800 feet a.s.l.) - Monreale (PA).

Soil: clay-rich soil, whit coarse rock fragments and outcrops.

Harvesting technique: manual harvest in boxes, second ten days of August.

Yield per hectare: 4 tons/ha.

Wine-making: soft crushing and fermentation in steel vats.

Maturation: on its own yeasts in steel vats for 9 months.

Refinement: in bottle for 2 months

Alcohol: 13. 03 %

Total acidity: 6.92 g/l.

pH: 3.05.

Production: 20,000 bottles.

Grape varieties: Catarratto 100%

Agronomic approach: certified organic.

Vineyard: Giambascio (1,000 feet a.s.l.) - S. Giuseppe Jato (PA).

Soil: clay-rich soil, loose and rich in earthy iron oxides.

Harvesting technique: manual harvest in boxes, second half of September.

Yield per hectare: 6 tons/ha.

Wine-making: soft crushing and fermentation in steel vats.

Maturation: on its own yeasts in steel vats (90%) and clayver (10%) for 7 months.

Refinement: in bottle for 2 months

Alcohol: 12.89 %

Total acidity: 6.37 g/l.

pH: 3.14.

Production: 13,000.

Maturation : on its own yeats in steel vats (70%) and clayer (30%) for 8 months.

Refinement: in bottle for 2 months

Alcohol: 13.47 %

Wine-making: destemming, 18-hour maceration and fermentation in tonneaux (Taransaud) both new and used.

Maturation: in new and used tonneaux (Taransaud) for 12 months.

Refinement: in bottle for 2 months

Harvesting technique: manual harvest in boxes, second ten days of September.

Yield per hectare: 5 tons/ha.

Wine-making: destemming, 34-day maceration and fermentation in steel vats.

Maturation: 50% in steel vats and 50% in a oak barrel for 6 months.

Refinement: in bottle for 3 months

Alcohol: 13.21 %




The Giato project

Giato is the name of the old district that surrounded amazing Greek theatre located on the top of Mount Jato. This place overlooks Jato Valley, Belice upland and the most important core of the Centopassi vineyards.

The peak of Mount Jato is on 850 meters on the sea level. This allowed, in the ancient time, to have a highly strategic position and to supervise, from one side, the crossing point to access in Conca (Horn of Plenty) and (old name of Palermo) Phoenician-Punic emporium and, from the other side, the Belice River Valley through which it was possible to reach Selinunte, ancient Greek colony, and the Sicilian South coast. This area was inhabited ever since the beginning of the first millennia before Christ by the ancient populations that settled on the islands as the Elymians-Sican. In this place, since the 300 before Christ, the Greek village of Jaitas has blossomed and lived its most flourishing period.

Giato wines are the result of only the most representative native grapes of western Sicily and derives their name from the ancient district that surrounded the wonderful Greek theater on Monte Jato. A place that dominates the valley of the river of the same name, the Belice plateau and the most important nucleus of the Centopassi vineyards.





Giato Grillo-Catarratto DOC Sicilia Superiore 2021

Grape varieties: Grillo 60%, Catarratto 40%

Agronomic approach: certified organic.

Vineyard: Verzanica (1,150 feet a.s.l.) - Monreale (PA).

Soil: moderately impermeable, with a low proportion of rock fragments and poor in organic content.

Harvesting technique: manual harvest in boxes, late August - late September.

Yield per hectare: 6 tons/ha.

Wine-making: soft crushing and fermentation in steel vats.

Maturation: in steel vats for 5 months.

Alcohol: 12.85 %

Total acidity: 6.50 g/l.

Wine-making: destemming, 8-day maceration and fermentation in steel vats.

Maturation: in steel vats (90%) and tonneaux Taransaud (10%) for 4 months.

Alcohol: 13.60 %

Total acidity: 5.50 g/l.
